January 22-26 is Kindness week in Conway. We hope that you are able to help us show kindness to our friends, family and community partners.

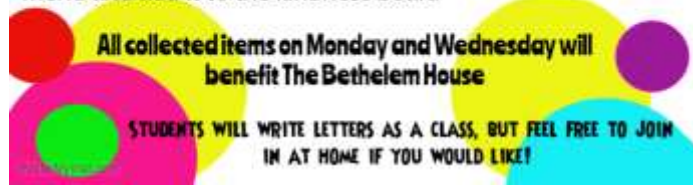
Monday: "Stock up on Kindness" Bring a common household item (paper towels, ziplock bags, trash bags, sponges, etc)
