Parents, in order to ensure the safety of all students and staff, in light of the recent national and local events, we want to reiterate our school's safety procedures. Any visitors who arrive after 8:10 will need to ring the bell outside. We ask that you please be prepared to show your ID and you may be asked to state the purpose of your visit. You will then need to check into the front office to have your ID scanned and given a visitor badge. No one will be allowed in the hallways without first checking in at the office, regardless of the time of day. This will also be the procedure when we have school events so you may want to arrive a few minutes early. Additionally, we want to make sure that parents understand that we cannot call students to the office to be checked out prior to your arrival. If you are checking your student out, you will need to come into the office, sign your student out and then they will be called to the office. This may add a few minutes to your commute, so please plan accordingly. For everyone who picks students up in the car rider line, please be sure to have your car rider sign. Not every teacher on duty can identify everyone authorized to pick up a student. Thank you for your help!
