Parents, we have reached our "independence day" for CLE. If you should need to enter the hallways, please be sure to check in at the front office to obtain a visitors tag.

Afternoon Pickup

When picking students up in the afternoon, we ask that you remain in the car rider line unless you have an emergency or pre-approved permission (doctor's appointment, therapy, after-school activity, etc) from Dr. Antley or Mrs. Williams to come into the office to call your student to the front office. Please be aware that if you do not have pre-approval to call your student to the office, that you may be asked to go back and wait in the car rider line. We ask for your cooperation with this matter so that we are able to do our part in ensuring that ALL 560 students get home in the correct manner. When we have an office full of people, it makes our jobs very difficult due to the shuffling of students, elevated noise levels, etc.

Also, please be aware that if you intend to check your student out at any point in the day that they will need to be called up to leave when you enter the office. Please do not ask for your student to be called up to leave at a specific time. This creates confusion and extra work on our staff. Thank you.
