Your student will soon be taking the new “MAP Growth” assessment. The “MAP Growth” is an online, technology-based test that students take on their chromebooks. It will be given to all students in Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grades this year. This is the new statewide assessment for K-2 students in the State of Arkansas.

This is a measurement of progress in both Reading and Math. We will administer the “MAP Growth” three times this year- in September, December, and April. The information/results gained from this assessment will be used by our teachers and staff to gauge your child’s learning and to tailor classroom instruction accordingly. **The “MAP Growth” does not count for a grade or points for your student.**

Your child’s teacher will go over the results from the first (September) “MAP Growth” assessment at Parent/Teacher Conferences in October, where you will have the opportunity to ask questions and learn more about this new assessment process.
